People / Place Who made the artwork? What do we know about them and their cultural and geographic context? If the artwork reflects the intersection of multiple cultures, be sure to include these details.

Process How was the artwork made? What materials, techniques, and styles were used? Does the process reflect specific innovations or traditions tied to the culture in which the artwork was created?

Power What are the ways that the artwork conveys power? Consider subject matter, circumstances of artistic production, as well as the museum history related to the artwork.

What remaining questions do you have about the artwork, the artist, the museum, or other details covered in the video?
